Day One Hometown to Dunedin Dinner

Day Two **Dunedin Sightseeing Cooked Breakfast & Dinner**

After a leisurely start this morning, we take a city sights tour of Dunedin, the capital of Otago before we drive to the tip of the Otago Peninsula - Taiaroa Heads, where the world's only mainland colony of Royal Albatross is found. We join a guided tour to the Richdale Observatory where the colony and nesting sites can be viewed. We visit Penguin Place, a private Yellow-Eyed Penguin conservation reserve, where a series of trenches and observation points throughout the reserve can have you within just metres of these endangered birds.

Dunedin – Kaka Pt, Catlins Cooked Breakfast, Picnic Lunch & Dinner Day Three

This morning we journey along the Southern Scenic route to the Catlins. A number of stops will be made enroute to view natural wonders, waterfalls, scenery and wildlife. There are numerous walking tracks leading to awe-inspiring treasures of the Catlins. We will walk some of the shorter tracks that are 10-45 minutes return.

This morning we join a bus tour and gain an insight into Stewart Island's community, history and environment. The remainder of the day is free for you to explore the local area at leisure. There are many short walks in and around Halfmoon Bay, and the DOC visitor centre and Museum both offer interesting displays.

This morning joining the short flight to Invercargill we are met by our coach driver and taken on short sightseeing trip to Bluff before checking into our central city accommodation. The remainder of the day is free to explore the city. 1 night
